**GREAT EVENTS IN DELAWARE COUNTY  
CREATE A SPECTACULAR SEPTEMBER FOR VISITORS**

DELAWARE, OH. Fairs, markets, art, and horses! Great events make September a spectacular time to visit Delaware County, Ohio.

**Panoramic Ohio:** On exhibit August 23 through September 23 at the Richard M. Ross Art Museum. This art exhibit features 75 panoramic color photographs from all over Ohio by Thomas Schiff. Hours: Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday, 10:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m.; Thursday, 10:00 a.m.-9:00 p.m.; Sunday, 1:00-5:00 p.m.; closed Monday and Saturday.

**Labor Day Flea Market on the Square:** On Monday, September 3, 7:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m., Sunbury, Ohio will host the annual Flea Market and Ox Roast on the square. The quaint village square will be packed with vendors. Visitors also enjoy exploring the antique and specialty shops located around the square and nearby.

**Historic Downtown Powell Street Market:** On Sunday, September 9, 9:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m., Historic Downtown Powell will host one of three annual Street Market days. Visitors will discover antiques, collectibles, crafts, plants, produce, great food, and more. Vendors line the streets for an old-fashioned street market.

**All Horse Parade:** Sunday, September 9 at 3:00 p.m. the annual All Horse Parade will march from the Delaware County Fairgrounds through Historic Downtown Delaware. This totally non-motorized parade features several hundred animals, and an impressive array of horse-drawn carriages. Marching bands also add excitement to the parade.

**Delaware County Fair:** September 15-22. This spectacular week-long event offers agricultural and livestock exhibits, entertainment, and a fun-filled midway. The Fair includes good old-fashioned fun, such as a corn hole and horse shoe tournaments, demolition derby, mud run, and a chili cook-off. Grand Circuit harness racing Sunday-Thursday, is another highlight visitors enjoy at the Fair. Harness racing excitement culminates with the Juliette on Wednesday, and Little Brown Jug on Thursday.

**Little Brown Jug:** Thursday, September 20, the Delaware County Fairgrounds will be packed with visitors for the 62<sup>nd</sup> Little Brown Jug. This *Great American Horse Race* is a premier race for 3-year-old pacers, and one of the jewels in the triple crown of Grand Circuit harness racing. The Little Brown Jug is possibly the only such race of its caliber to take place during a traditional county fair.

Often the travel season slows down when children go back to school at the end of August. In Delaware County, there are still lots of fun things for visitors to see and do through September and beyond!
